

CIRCULAR NO. 4 DATED 16th October 2016

AMENDMENT TO VISA TARRIF SCHEDULE FOR DUBAI WORLD TRADE CENTRE AUTHORITY RULES AND REGULATIONS

This Circular relates to the Dubai World Trade Centre Authority Free Zone Rules and Regulations dated 1 October 2015. Terms defined in the Free Zone Rules & Regulations shall have the same meaning in this Circular.

With effect from the date of this Circular and pursuant to Rule 20 of the Dubai World Trade Centre Authority Free Zone Rules and Regulations issued on 1 October 2015, the Authority amends the following Rules and Regulations with the intent to provide stages for visa associated fees in the event of termination of the remainder of that process.

The table below provides the relevant tariffs:

This Circular is designated as part of the Free Zone Rules & Regulations, and must be read in conjunction with the Free Zone Rules & Regulations and any other amendments, circulars or notices issued by Dubai World Trade Centre Authority from time to time.

This Circular and any obligations arising out of or in connection with it are governed by, and shall be construed in accordance with, the laws of Dubai World Trade Centre Authority and, to the extent applicable, the federal laws of the United Arab Emirates.

Rule 19 of the Free Zone Rules and regulations shall apply to this Circular as if set out full herein.
